# Background


## & Ethos

Our School bloomed with just 7 blossoms in the year 1998. As it progressed, the school established itself as a Matriculation Higher Secondary School, offering students a challenging curriculum and an enriching academic programme from Kindergarten to Grade 12. The school campus is set over an area of 5 acres of land. The building spans over 50,000 sq.ft and consists of smart classrooms, activity rooms, laboratories, computer room, library and office area. The size of each classroom is 30 x 20 ft with adequate windows for good ventilation and lighting. The seating arrangements are specially designed according to the age and height of the children. Ionized pure drinking water is available at the campus. There is a separate block for washroom, with tiled floor, which ensures good hygiene. A vast area is dedicated to the playground. There is a big courtyard for conducting the school assembly. In short, it is a safe, serene and self-contained campus.



# School Aim

Primarily, at Century, we aim at providing a welcoming, peaceful and congenial environment which enables the students to actively participate in learning. The activities that we provide in our school ultimately help them to develop self-confidence and self-esteem. # Admission Procedure

## Check list

The Admission Process is designed to enroll students not only demonstrating promise but also other worthy children. A registration form is included with the prospectus. Registration does not imply admission, but it is subject to the availability of seats and fulfilling of the admission criteria. Prospectus and registration forms are available only on specified dates as displayed on the notice board at school campus.

Students from other schools seeking admission at Century should submit the following details:

- Filled-in application form
- Transfer certificate
- Photocopy of the birth certificate
- Photocopy of the community certificate
- Student's photo – 1 (passport size)
- Photocopy of the ration card
- Students from other states have to produce migration certificate, students from other boards like CBSE, ICSE etc., should get their TC counter signed from their District Education Department. For 11<sup>th</sup> admission 10<sup>th</sup> std mark sheet and original TC should be produced.



# Curriculum


## School Library

### Curriculum:

We have developed a curriculum which ensures that our students are involved, inspired and curious about the world around them. The curriculum provides challenges and choice for our children taking into account the uniqueness of each child and his/ her individual needs. Across the curriculum we have an emphasis on the development of skills and capabilities for lifelong learning and for operating effectively in society in the years to come.

### School Library:

The library is well furnished, ventilated and spacious with an excellent and comprehensive collection of books, magazines, encyclopedias, journals, periodicals, CDs' and DVDs' in order to broaden the student's intellectual and cognitive horizons. Besides this, the school subscribes the local and national news papers in order to keep them abreast of the happenings around them.



# Science Laboratories

We have well-equipped and spaciouly designed Physics, Chemistry and Biology labs. Each student has an individual apparatus for practical work. Also, there are many specimens, models, slides, instruments, etc., available to facilitate their learning. It is noteworthy to mention that the Chemistry lab has been furnished with LPG gas connection with a lab attendant in order to facilitate learning in the most effective manner.

## Language Lab:

We have introduced the best Language Lab solution which is the integration of the state of the art software with the present day digital hardware technology in teaching spoken English. The new concept in this software is "The software is the teacher; the language lab - the media and the teacher - the facilitator". The voice in the software is unique. The students while hearing back their recorded sound gradually develop confidence to speak English.



# Computer Lab

Communication and computer based education are definitely the direction towards which the whole world is progressing. Our future generation is already showing signs of becoming Techno-Smart. That's why today computers have become inevitable towards imparting education.

Our computer lab is a well-designed, false-roofed, fluorescent-lamps-lit, beautifully-decorated one. There are 40 computers, consisting of Intel Pentium Core 2 Duo processors, with 2 GB RAM for high processing speeds. All the computers are connected through LAN. Each computer has been loaded with innovative software to back up the challenging curriculum. Broadband Internet connectivity is available to facilitate the learning process.



# Digital Classroom

## Co-curricular Activities

Digital classroom is an experience of powerful medium of digital video technology. At Digital classroom we provide curriculum to cover the broad scope of the State Board Syllabus with additional input.

We believe that the students today should be exposed to the vast array of technology that is available. By using Digital classroom, students get hands-on experience with the technologies that make the Digital age as powerful as can be.

### Science Projects:

Every year our projects have been selected for the presentation at State Level and three times at the National level.


# Academic Excellence Achievements
